


## INFORMATION

## **ENTRY FEE: \$25.00 LUNKER POOL: \$10.00**

25% of Entry total will be donated to American Cancer Society

1<sup>ST</sup> Place.....35%  
2<sup>nd</sup> Place.....25%  
3<sup>rd</sup> Place.....15%  
Lunker Pool.....100%

Starting position is at your favorite fishing spot anywhere on the Delaware River and or its tributaries, no earlier than 7:00am.

Check in time is 3:00pm. No fish will be weighed in after 3:00pm so allow yourself enough time to return to the club and weigh in your fish.

Tournament will be held rain or shine.

**ENTRY INCLUDES FOOD, SODA, AND DRAFT BEER FROM 3:00PM TO 8:00PM.**

Anyone not fishing the tournament who would like to attend the event will pay an admission price of \$20.00. Children under 12 pay \$5.00.

This Tournament is open to anyone over 18 years old, a parent, or a responsible adult with parent's permission must accompany anyone under 18

Tournament judges may penalize or disqualify any entrant for any violation of the Tournament rules, state fishing regulations or unsportsmanlike conduct. No fees will be refunded.

## **Rules and Regulations**

1. You may begin fishing at 7am
2. Fishing can be done by land or boat
3. All fish must be caught by conventional sporting method using a rod & reel. Netting, spearing or foul hooking is NOT permitted.
4. All boats must be safe and have their proper registration, and contain the required US Coast Guard approved safety equipment.
5. Tournament fishing is open to all areas on the Delaware River & its Tributaries.
6. 3 catfish per person can be weighed in.
7. All your fish must be alive, released, and be able to swim away after they are weighed in.
8. Anglers can only weigh in 1 time.
9. Flathead Catfish Prohibited

**LUNKER POOL:** 100% payout. If you entered in the Lunker Pool it is up to you to determine your heaviest fish. After Lunker fish is weighed your other 2 fish will be added for a total combined weight.

Your boats live well, etc. may be inspected either before or at any time during the tournament

**Note:** Fish will not be weighed individually or measured. In the event of a tie the money will be split up evenly to those place holders.

Any grievances must be made to the judge prior to weigh in. They must be presented within 15 minutes of notification. The judge's decision, in all matters, is final.

Having acquainted myself with the rules, I hereby waive the National Park Boat Club, and it's members and officers, and other contestants of all claims or personal injury and property damage incurred by me while participating in this event. I have clear understanding of all tournament rules by proof of my signature on the entry form.
